

Dear Parents,


We have been sponsoring two children in Africa for the last 6 years. Thembo, a 10 year old in Uganda, and Fatima, a 12 year old in Tanzania would never have had the chance to go to school, receive nutritional support or have access to medical care if they had not been sponsored through Compassion, and all this from children bringing in just 20p each month.

I recently met with one of the directors from Compassion and he is immensely grateful for the sponsorship Reigate St Mary's provides. Having seen first-hand the difference that this can make to the life and health of a child, and even more importantly to their future prospects, he knows that such a small amount of money truly lifts a child out of poverty and transforms their life chances.

Because it takes so little to make such a big difference, it struck me that it would be fantastic if Reigate St Mary's could sponsor more than two children. Therefore I put it to the Form Reps that we might aim for sponsoring one child per class. This equates to just £18 a year per family if the majority of families were in agreement. There is of course no obligation at all for parents to sign up but any family that is willing to commit to £18 a year, added to the fee bill, would be enough to sponsor one child per class from Year 1 upwards and two children across the Reception classes. By doing this it would lift a further twelve children out of poverty and give them the chance of a real future and the opportunity to make a difference in their own communities.

When I raised this proposal with the Form Reps, the feedback was that the majority of parents were in favour of such an initiative. Of course some of you already give generously to other causes and may not feel that you can give to more charitable organisations and that is absolutely fine.



The other concern was that by ticking a box and simply donating money yearly it might remove the sense of relationship between a child's giving and the recipient in a far off land. Therefore, what I have suggested is that children continue to bring in their 20p pieces on the first Monday of each month and in this way we can provide each sponsored child with an annual birthday present and if enough money is generated we might even sponsor yet another child through Compassion. But more importantly because each class will be responsible for a child they will be writing letters to their sponsored child and learning about life in a different part of the world.

If as many of you as feel able are willing to support this worthy cause it equates to about 35p a week per family. Thank you for taking the time to read this letter and considering joining in with this initiative.
