Dear Parents

Welcome to Kindergarten! We hope you have had a lovely summer. We are looking forward to an exciting and successful year with your children.

Our topic for the Autumn Term will be *Our Wonderful World*. This half term we will be focusing on the theme *Ourselves*. The seven areas of learning will be delivered through a wide range of activities and experiences both inside and outdoors. During the first few weeks we will be helping the children to settle into Kindergarten routines. We will also be talking about ourselves and our families.

As a school we focus on one thinking skill and one value for each half term which are woven into every aspect of school life. Our value is *Courage* and our thinking skill is *Good Judgement*. We will be incorporating these into our everyday activities and experiences.

Please help your child to choose an appropriate book and bring it into school during their allocated week. We will put a copy of the rota into your child's book bag during the first week of school.

Uniform and belongings

Please ensure ALL belongings are clearly labelled, including shoes, wellies and lunch boxes. The children will sign in and hang their coats up as they come into the classroom, then put their book bag into their tray. The trays are located in either the Rhyming Rabbits area or the Counting Crocodiles area and we will show you on the first day where to locate them.

We will send your child's new communication book home during the first week. Please keep the book in your child's book bag and check it daily for any messages. A member of the Kindergarten Team will also check the book on a daily basis. There will be a weekly timetable on the inside cover of the book, and we will write a note once a week to let you know what the children have been doing during the week. We also use the Tapestry website as your child's online learning journal, and if you do not already have login details for this, you will receive them shortly.
