Teacher of Piano

The Music Department at Reigate St. Mary's wishes to appoint a teacher of piano to start from September 2024.

Peripatetic teachers working at Reigate St. Mary's are self-employed and bill parents direct in advance, according to an agreed school rate, which will be £49 per hour from September for individual lessons (lessons are usually 30 minutes). There are terms and conditions in place which the parents agree to when applying for lessons, and which cover such cases as absence from lessons and notice of termination of lessons. Lessons are timetabled on a rota by the teacher on a day or days convenient for the teacher and the school.

Reigate St. Mary's is a choir school and offers many opportunities for children to make music. There are currently 4 choirs in addition to our elite Godfrey Searle Choristers and 5 instrumental ensembles. Concerts for soloists and groups are regularly held in addition to hosting exams and performing in the community. As a junior school to Reigate Grammar School and sister school to Chinthurst School and Micklefield School, we have a good working relationship with their music departments.

The ideal candidate will have experience working as a Visiting Music Teacher and an ability to balance their professional work with their teaching commitments.
